Event Registration

Registration to the Buddy Werner Championships is an event entry by team. Head coaches &/o Program Directors should prepare their team's registration. The event fee is \$190/athlete and includes 2 days of racing, 1 day of training, 3-day lift ticket, awards, banquet, raffle items/prizes, backpack and souvenirs. Athlete lunches can be pre-ordered with the team registration, as well as orders for t-shirts and sweatshirts can be included.

T-shirts and Sweatshirts

Athlete t-shirt and sweatshirt orders are due with the team payment/registration by 12:00 noon, on March 2nd. Additional adult size garments will be available for purchase at the event.

Athlete Lunches

Lunches for the athletes are available all 3 days and will be served in tents at both Skibowl East (SL venue) and Skibowl West (GS venue). Lunches need to be pre-ordered on the Team Payment Form. Hamburgers and shredded chicken sandwiches will be served along with potato salad, chips and drinks.

Parent Lift Tickets

A 3-day lift ticket for parents is available for \$115 and can be pre-ordered on the Team Payment Form. Daily tickets will be \$45.

Souvenir Bibs

These are included in every athlete's registration and are \$15 each. If an athlete wishes to return the souvenir bib, the \$15 will be refunded.

Team Registration-Arrival Night

Takes place at Cascade Ski Club in Government Camp, Thursday, March 12th from 6:00-8:00pm. Coaches will pick up: Backpacks, souvenirs, bibs, t-shirts, sweatshirts, start lists, training day schedule (training and team photos), banquet info sheet, and any other information.

Training Day

Teams will train together on a staggered schedule on both the GS and SL venues. The GS course will be shared and re-set as needed. Multiple SL courses will be set. Teams are welcome to bring SL gates (although not required) and coaches are welcome to help with SL setting.

Teams will also have a team photo time coordinated with their training block. Team photos will take place by the Multorpor Lodge, Skibowl East.

Opening Ceremonies

Opening Ceremonies, Friday, March 12th, will take place in downtown Government Camp, in front of Cascade Ski Club. Teams will line up on East Blossom Trail at 3:30 PM. Teams will begin to Parade into the Cascade Ski Club parking lot at 4:00 PM. After teams have assembled, speakers will welcome and address the crowd.
